As requested, we have reviewed the final amendments to the Arizona r Radiaions contained in rule packages RMP-0058 and RMP-0059. In addiaion, we reviewed your responses to our letter, dated June 27, 2003, which contained our iniaial comments on the Arizona Administriaive Code. The rules were received by our office on October 20, 2003. These r Radiaions were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) r Radiaions in 10 CFR Parts 20 and 34 and the requirements of the four amendments identified in the enclosed States Regulation Status Data Sheet (SRS). We discussed our review of the reRadiaions with Daniel Kuhl on November 3, 2003.

As a r sult of our review, we have no comments. Please note that we have limited our review to reRadiaions required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that the reRadiaions, as adopted, meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Arizona r Radiaions, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
