If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at 844-244-6694 for airline reservations, and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to credit card ending 2835. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for Chattanooga, Tennessee is \$95 hotel and \$64 meals and incidentals.
