CHANGE OF REGIONAL STATE AGREEMENT OFFICERS (RSAOs) AND REGIONAL STATE LIAISON OFFICERS (RSLOs) PERSONNEL (FSME-07-030)

We are pleased to announce the following new Regional State Agreements Officers (RSAOs) and Regional State Liaison Officers (RSLOs), who join our other experienced RSAOs and RSLOs in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) State coordination duties.
