**NOTIFICATION OF NEW WEBINAR SERIES FOR STATES AND FIRST SCHEDULED
SESSION ON POWER REACTOR DECOMMISSIONING (FSME-14-032)**

Purpose: To provide: 1) notification of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's plans to begin a periodic webinar series covering various topics of interest for State audiences, 2) details on the first planned webinar session on power reactor decommissioning on May 6, 2014, and 3) opportunity to provide suggestions for future webinar sessions.*

Background: The NRC strives to conduct effective communications and outreach to State counterparts on topics of mutual interest. NRC staff has been evaluating additional opportunities to support that goal, particularly those that make use of available conferencing technologies, and plans to initiate a webinar series for State audiences. NRC staff will periodically seek input from States for webinar topic suggestions and strive to cover a diverse range of topics over time.

Planned topics include: the power reactor decommissioning process, current status of decommissioning in the United States, and emergency preparedness aspects.
