REQUEST FOR COMMENTS - DRAFT PROPOSED RULE: 10 CFR PARTS 20, 30, 31, 32, 33, 35, 50, 61, 62, 72, AND 150 "EXPANDED DEFINITION OF BYPRODUCT MATERIAL" (STP-06-001)

NRC has posted the draft proposed rule entitled "10 CFR Parts 20, 30, 31, 32, 33, 35, 50, 61, 62, 72, and 150, Expanded Definition of Byproduct Material," for your review and comment. This draft is ready for comment by Agreement States, Non-Agreement States, the Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI), and NRC management, before it is released for public comment. Please provide comments directly to Lydia Chang at Iwc1@nrc.gov on or before '5:00 p.m., February 2, 2006.

Section 651(e) of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 requires the NRC to expand the definition of byproduct material to include naturally occurring and accelerator-produced radioactive material NARM. The draft proposed rule would amend NRC regulations to include certain NARM.

The draft proposed rule is predecisional and is available at the Agreement State area of the NRC's Technical Conference Forum http://techconf.llnl.gov/cgi-states/topics. (Non-Agreement States may obtain passwords for the Technical Conference Forum from the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors.) The draft is marked: "OFFICIAL USE ONLY - SENSITIVE INTERNAL INFORMATION - NOT FOR PUBLIC DISCLOSURE."

Due to their predecisional nature, the draft is exempt from public disclosure under NRC rules. Therefore, we request that you limit distribution to your staff and not release the draft publicly.
