Purpose: To inform the States of a management change in the Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME).

Background: I am pleased to announce that James G. Luehman has been selected for the position of Deputy Director, Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, FSME.



Discussion: Mr. Luehman joined the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in 1983 as a Resident Inspector. After serving as a Resident Inspector in Region II and Senior Resident Inspector in Region IV, he transferred to Headquarters in 1987 as a Senior Enforcement Specialist in the Office of Enforcement. From 1993 until 2000 he has served as a Senior Reactor Engineer and Senior Environmental Project Manager in the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, and as an Inspection Team Leader in the Special Projects Office. In 2000, Mr. Luehman was selected as the Deputy Director, Office of Enforcement. He received a B.S. degree from the U.S. Naval Academy. Mr. Luehman is a 2007 graduate of the NRC SES Candidate Development Program; 1995 graduate of the NRC Supervisory Development Program; and was an NRC Congressional Fellow in 1995-1996, serving as a Senior Policy Analyst for energy and the environment on the staff of Congressman Fred Upton (R-MI).
