FINAL RULE -- FEE RECOVERY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008 (FSME-08-052)

Purpose: This is to inform you that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has published a final rule to modify 10 CFR Parts 170 and 171 regarding the licensing, inspection, and annual fees to recover approximately 90 percent of its fiscal year (FY) 2008 budget authority.

Background: The amendments are necessary in order to implement the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990 (OBRA-90), as amended, which mandates that NRC recover through fees approximately 90 percent of its FY 2008 budget authority, less the amount appropriated from the Nuclear Waste Fund and for Waste Incidental to Reprocessing activities and generic homeland security activities. The final rule modifies the fees assessed to those Agreement State licensees who perform work in Non-Agreement States under the reciprocity provisions of 10 CFR 150.20. The final rule was published in the *Federal Register* (FR) on June 6, 2008 (73 FR 32386) and the effective date of the rule is August 5, 2008. The reciprocity fee can be found as Category 16 in the 10 CFR 170.31, Schedule of Materials Fees, on page 32406 of the June 6, 2008 FR notice. The fee decreased from \$1,500.00 for FY 2007 to \$1,400.00 for FY 2008. Please inform your licensees of the final fee rule and how they can access it.

The proposed rule was sent to each State under separate cover, with a memorandum summarizing the proposed changes. The proposed rule was also made available on the NRC web site. The NRC does not plan to routinely mail the FY 2008 final fee rule or future final fee rules as a cost saving measure.
