NOTIFICATION OF RESCHEDULING OF NRC PUBLIC MEETING ON CUMULATIVE
EFFECTS OF REGULATIONS (FSME-13-038)

Purpose: To notify the Agreement States that the U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) category 3 public meeting on Cumulative Effects of Regulation (CER) previously scheduled on April 24, 2013 is rescheduled for May 8, 2013 (Enclosure 1).

Background: By a letter dated April 22, 2013, FSME-13-029, you were informed of an upcoming public meeting on CER. The CER initiative evaluates the challenges that licensees, or other impacted entities (such as State partners) face while implementing new regulatory positions, programs, or requirements (e.g., rules, generic letters, backfits, and inspections). Subsequent to the April 22 letter, the NRC decided to change the date of the public meeting to facilitate broader participation

Discussion: The NRC is hosting a public meeting to obtain feedback on issues related to the implementation of the CER rulemaking process enhancements. This feedback will be used to inform a future Commission paper. States may participate remotely on the internet and via a toll-free audio teleconference bridgeline. The meeting notice is enclosed.
