**PENDING EXPIRATION OF THE NRC TYPE B TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE  
CERTIFICATE FOR SENTINEL™ MODEL 660 SERIES RADIOGRAPHIC PROJECTORS ON  
JUNE 30, 2013 (FSME-13-047)**

**Purpose:** The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has issued an Information Notice (IN) to inform its licensees and the Agreement States about the June 30, 2013 expiration of Certificate of Compliance No. 9283 for the SENTINEL™ Model 660 Series radiographic projectors.

**Background:** As specified in the regulations, once a certification expires, a package cannot be shipped or transported legally. A valid certificate must be in place to allow legal transport in accordance with international and United States regulations.

**Discussion:** On July 1, 2013, the Model 660 Series device will no longer be an NRC-authorized transportation package. On this date, an approved package other than the Model 660 Series must be used for transport of the 660 Series radiography sources. This applies to the following models: 660, 660E, 660A, 660AE, 660B and 660BE. Complete information can be found in IN 2013-08:
