REVISION 1, "CONSOLIDATED GUIDANCE ABOUT MATERIALS LICENSES:
PROGRAM-SPECIFIC GUIDANCE ABOUT 10 CFR PART 36 IRRADIATOR LICENSES"
(FSME-13-085)

Purpose: To provide the Agreement States with the opportunity to comment* on the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) draft NUREG-1556, Volume 6, Revision 1, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about 10 CFR Part 36 Irradiator Licenses."

Background: The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is revising the licensing guidance in the NUREG-1556 series. The NRC last revised and published NUREG-1556, Volume 6, in January 1999. The document is intended for use by applicants, licensees and NRC staff, and is also available to the Agreement States.

Discussion: NUREG-1556, Volume 6, Revision 1, has been updated by a working group made up of NRC and Agreement State representatives, to include safety culture, security of radioactive materials, protection of sensitive information and changes in regulatory policies and practices. The notice announcing the availability of the draft volume for comment was published in the *Federal Register* (78 FR 53791) on August 30, 2013:
