CLOSEOUT OF STATE AGREEMENTS (SA) PROCEDURE SA-121 "AGREEMENT STATE LIAISON TO THE MANAGEMENT REVIEW BOARD" (STC-20-069)

**Purpose**: To inform the National Materials Program (NMP) community that State Agreements (SA) Procedure SA-121 "Agreement State Liaison to the Management Review Board" (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML13281A465) has been rescinded.

**Background**: The procedure SA-121 provided guidance to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Organization of Agreement States (OAS) staff on the roles and responsibilities, coordination, and participation of the Agreement State representatives on the Management Review Board (MRB).

**Discussion**: The procedure SA-106, "The Management Review Board" contains the criteria and guidelines to be followed by the MRB when conducting MRB meetings for IMPEP reviews and issuing findings for NRC and Agreement State programs. In addition, SA-106 was revised to address revisions incorporated into Management Directive (MD) 5.6, "Integrated Materials Performance Evaluation Program (IMPEP)," which included clarification on the composition of the Management Review Board, final determinations, and a new appeal process. To reduce unnecessary duplication, the guidance provided in SA-121 has been included, as appropriate, in SA-106, and SA-121 has been rescinded.
