NOTIFICATION OF AN UPCOMING WEBINAR ON THE U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY
COMMISSION REACTOR OVERSIGHT PROCESS (STC-15-076)

Purpose: To provide notification that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff will conduct a Reactor Oversight Process (ROP) Webinar on November 10, 2015, as part of the ongoing State Liaison Officers Webinar training series.

Background: The ROP is NRC's program to inspect, measure, and assess the safety performance of commercial Nuclear Power Plants and to respond to any identified significant decline in performance.

Discussion: The NRC continues to seek ways to provide technical support for training and to engage States and Tribes on topics of interest. This Webinar is part one of a two part series on the ROP. This two part Webinar will address the ROP history, discuss events leading to its development and describe the ROP and its components/programs. Moreover, the ROP series will provide key ROP terms, concepts, and sources of information. Part one of the series, which will address the ROP history and events leading to its development, is scheduled for November 10, 2015, from 2 p.m. – 3 p.m. (ET).
