INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

<u>COURSE:</u> This course will be conducted beginning at 8:00 a.m. and end at 5:00 p.m. each day except for Friday, April 27, 2007, when the class is scheduled to end at 3:00 p.m. A course outline is below. Students should bring an engineering or scientific calculator with them. Normal office/business attire is appropriate for students attending TTC courses.
