RESCHEDULING OF TRAINING COURSES DUE TO THE FEDERAL
GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN (FSME-13-111)

Purpose: To provide an update on the training courses scheduled for next month's federal government shutdown.

Discussion: In light of numerous factors including the uncertainty of the duration of the federal government shutdown, all courses currently scheduled through and including the week of November 4, 2013 will be rescheduled for dates after the first of the year.

All travelers that were accepted to any of the following courses will need to call Carlson Travel immediately to cancel airline reservations and hotel reservations.*

Environmental Monitoring Course (H-111) – October 21-25, 2013 Inspection
Procedures Course (G-108) – October 28-November 1, 2013 Licensing Practices
and Procedures Course (G-109) – November 4-8, 2013 NRC Materials Control &
Security Systems & Principles (S-201) – November 4-8, 2013 Characterization
and Planning for Decommissioning (H-115) – November 4-8, 2013
Root Cause Workshop (G-205) – November 4-8, 2013

In addition, the webinar scheduled for October 17, 2013 on Performance Based Inspection training will be rescheduled for a later date.

The two training classes scheduled for the week of October 7, 2013 and postponed last week will also be rescheduled. Those classes were: Root Cause Workshop (G-205) and Visual Sampling Plan (H-500).
