No rental cars are authorized for invitational travel. The per diem for Chattanooga, Tennessee is 95/56/151. This means lodging/meals/not to exceed total per day. Tax is a separate line item on your voucher. Effective January 1, 2013 reimbursement for mileage is 56.5 cents per mile. Please be sure to choose a hotel within the Chattanooga vicinity and within per diem.
