**LODGING AND TRAVEL:** Please plan to arrive on Monday, June 6, 2016, and depart on Friday, June 10, 2016. Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your flight to credit card ending 2835. Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to Marcia Casby, AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than April 8. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for Chattanooga, Tennessee is \$95 hotel and \$64 meals and incidentals. A complimentary shuttle has been arranged for transportation between the hotel and the training center for individuals staying at the Residence Inn hotel listed below.
