LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, November 13, 2016, and depart on Friday, November 18, 2016. Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to Sandra Rodriguez, AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than Friday, October 7. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for Chattanooga, Tennessee is \$100 for hotel and \$64 for meals and incidentals. A complimentary shuttle has been arranged for transportation between the hotel and the training center for individuals staying at the Residence Inn hotel listed below.
