## **INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS**

ACCEPTANCE: This is to advise you that individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Environmental Risk Assessment (H-420) course. This course is scheduled to be presented at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) Professional Development Center (PDC) May 8-12, 2017. The PDC is located at our Three White Flint North Building which is situated across Marinelli Road from One White Flint North between the White Flint Metro station entrance and the Metro parking garage. The address for the building is 11601 Landsdown Street, North Bethesda, MD 20852. Please allow sufficient time to process through security upon arrival. You will be required to show proof of identification when you arrive. After you have processed through security, you will be escorted by an NRC employee to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor where the training will be held.

<u>COURSE</u>: Please note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, May 8, 2017, and will end at 12:30 p.m. on Friday, May 12, 2017. *You will be required to use your personal laptop in the classroom, so please be sure to bring it with you.* 

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, May 7, 2017, and depart on Friday, May 12, 2017. Students may elect to depart on Saturday, May 13 if they are unable to select a suitable flight departing after 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 12. Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at 844-244-6694 for airline reservations, and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable Government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to credit card ending 2835. Flights may be converted by Marcia Casby to less costly, non-refundable tickets, so please select carefully. Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to Marcia Casby, <a href="mailto:AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov">AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov</a>, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than Friday, March 17, 2017. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for North Bethesda, Maryland is \$242 hotel and \$69 meals and incidentals.
