<u>COURSE</u>: Please see our Web site, <u>http://scp.nrc.gov/training.html</u> for the Tentative Course Schedule and note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, August 28, 2017, and ends at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, September 1, 2017.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, August 27, 2017, and depart on Friday, September 1, 2017. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Friday, September 1st, you may elect to depart on Saturday, September 2nd. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday, September 2nd.

Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at 844-244-6694 for airline reservations, and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to credit card ending 2835. Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to Marcia Casby, <u>AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov</u>, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than Friday, June 30th. Attendees will be reimbursed at the NRC's contracted group rate of \$149 for the hotel listed below. Meals & Incidentals will be reimbursed via a per diem rate of \$69 per day. For the first and last day of travel the reimbursement is 75 percent of \$69 (i.e. \$51.75). The Marriott Residence Inn Denver-Cherry Creek is immediately across from and within easy walking distance to the training site. If you are authorized to drive, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 53.5 cents per mile.
