<u>COURSE</u>: Please see our website, <u>https://scp.nrc.gov/training.html</u> for the Tentative Course Schedule and note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, November 6, 2017 and ends at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 9, 2017.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, November 5, 2017 and depart on Thursday, November 9, 2017. Please plan to attend the course through the stated end time of 4:00 p.m. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Thursday, November 9th, you may elect to depart on Friday, November 10th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Thursday night and per diem on Friday, November 10th.

Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to Marcia Casby, <u>AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov</u>, no later than Friday, September 15th. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for Arlington, Texas is \$163 hotel and \$59 meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent which is \$44.25.
