**NOTIFICATION OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 INTEGRATED MATERIALS PERFORMANCE
EVALUATION PROGRAM TEAM MEMBER TRAINING (STC-17-077)**

Purpose: To inform the Agreement States of the upcoming Integrated Materials Performance Evaluation Program (IMPEP) team member training and to solicit interested participants.

Background: The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) uses IMPEP to ensure that public health and safety are adequately protected from the potential hazards associated with the use of radioactive materials and that Agreement State programs are compatible with NRC's program. IMPEP employs a team of NRC and Agreement State staff to assess both Agreement State and the NRC radioactive materials programs. Routinely, the NRC offers the IMPEP Team Member Training to the NRC and Agreement State radiation control program employees with an interest in performing IMPEP reviews.

Discussion: The Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) is soliciting interest from the Agreement States for IMPEP review team members. Program Directors should submit names of their staff interested in participating on IMPEP review teams to the contact person below via e-mail within 30 days of receipt of this letter. Any Agreement State staff member is eligible to participate on an IMPEP review team as long as they can meet the criteria to be a principal reviewer for at least one IMPEP performance indicator, as described in NMSS Procedure SA-111, "[Formal Qualifications for Integrated Materials Performance Evaluation Program Team Members and Team Leaders](#)."

The NRC fiscal year (FY) 2018 IMPEP team member training is being held February 13–15, 2018, in Rockville, Maryland. Attendees should expect to commit 4-5 days to this training, including travel time (2½ days of training and 1-2 days of travel time depending on flight availability and distance). Specific travel instructions will be provided to interested Agreement State staff in a separate correspondence. The NRC will reimburse costs incurred due to travel to and from the IMPEP team member training in accordance with Federal travel regulations.

The IMPEP team member training in February may also serve as refresher training for existing IMPEP team members who are supporting an FY 2018 IMPEP and did not participate on an IMPEP review or attend IMPEP team member training in the last 2 years. Agreement State team members in need of refresher training will be notified individually by either the NRC-headquarters IMPEP project manager or their State's Regional State Agreement Officer, and have the option of either attending the in-person February training or participating in online refresher training.
