INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

<u>ACCEPTANCE</u>: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Safety Aspects of Industrial Radiography (H-305) Course. This course is scheduled to be presented January 13-17, 2025, provided by instructors from Source Production and Equipment Company (SPEC), 113 Teal Street, St. Rose, Louisiana. The telephone number for the training site is (504) 464-9471.

COURSE: The course starts at 8:00 a.m. local time on Monday, January 13th and ends at 12:00 p.m. local time on Friday, January 17th.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, January 12th, and depart on Friday, January 17th. Please plan to attend the course through the stated end time of 12:00 p.m. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Friday, you may elect to depart early on Saturday, January 18th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday. Students need to make their lodging and air travel arrangements through El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare, El Sol Travel will direct bill the NRC for the flight. Traveler is responsible for providing a personal credit card to El Sol to reserve the hotel at the federal rate or lower, hotels are not direct billed to NRC. If the need arises and you must make a change and/or cancel, contact Karen Meyer at (301) 465-0791 at least 2 weeks prior to the course.

Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but **no later** than, Friday, January 3rd. The per diem for Kenner, Louisiana is \$157 for hotel and \$80 for meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent. Students are responsible for their own transportation (taxi/uber/subway, etc.) between the hotel and the training center. If you are authorized to drive your personal vehicle, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 67 cents per mile.

- State vehicles are not authorized for mileage reimbursement.
- Rental cars are not authorized for reimbursement.
- Airport parking is allowed for personal and State vehicles; however, we will only reimburse up to the standard rate (i.e., no valet parking).

In addition, you will need complete the attached NRC-64 voucher for reimbursement upon return from travel, **no later** than, Friday, January 24th. Review the itemized list for accuracy, including hotel, hotel tax and any additional authorized expenses. Additional expenses that were not included may be denied on a case-by-case bases. Sign the NRC-64 and e-mail back to AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov as one document with your hotel (individual days & a zero balance), taxi/uber (tip not to exceed 15%), flight receipt, and any other receipts over \$75.

Further instructions, including course agenda, will be provided via email or on the first day of the course to selected students.
