INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

ACCEPTANCE: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Irradiator Technology (H-315) course. This course is scheduled to be presented February 11-14, 2025 at the Residence Inn by Marriott Anaheim Hills Yorba Linda. The Residence Inn is located at 125 S. Festival Dr, Anaheim, CA 92808. COURSE: Please note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. pacific time on Tuesday, February 11th and ends at 12:00 p.m. pacific time on Friday, February 14th.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Monday, February 10th, and depart on Friday, February 14th. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Friday, you may elect to depart on Saturday, February 15th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday. Students need to make their lodging and air travel arrangements through El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 for airline reservations and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to the NRC. If the need arises and you must make a change, contact Karen Meyer at (301) 415-0113.

Please complete the Travel Information & Estimated Expenses Form which will be provided to you and submit to AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than, Friday, January 31st. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for Anaheim Hills, CA is \$191 for hotel and \$86 for meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent. Students are responsible for their own transportation between the hotel and the training center. If you are authorized to drive, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 67 cents per mile. Rental cars are **not** authorized for reimbursement.
