INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

<u>ACCEPTANCE</u>: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Licensing Practices and Procedures (G-109) Course. This course is scheduled to be presented March 31-April 3, 2025, at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Technical Training Center (TTC). The TTC is located at 5746 Marlin Road, Suite 200, Osborne Office Center (near Eastgate Shopping Center) Chattanooga, Tennessee 37411-5677. The facility's telephone number is (423) 855-6500.

COURSE: Please note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. eastern time on Monday, March 31st, and ends at 5:00 p.m. eastern time on Thursday, April 3rd.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, March 30th, and depart on Thursday, April 3rd. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Thursday, you may elect to depart on Friday, April 4th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday. Students **must** make their lodging (recommended hotels listed below) and air travel arrangements through El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to the NRC. If the need arises and you must make a change, contact Karen Meyer at (301) 415-0113.

Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than, Friday, March 21st. The per diem for Chattanooga, TN is \$117 for hotel and \$74 for meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent. Students are responsible for their own transportation (taxi/uber/subway, etc.) between the hotel and the training center. If you are authorized to drive your personal vehicle, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 70 cents per mile.

- State vehicles are not authorized for mileage reimbursement.
- Rental cars are not authorized for reimbursement.
- Airport parking is allowed for personal and State vehicles; however, we will only reimburse up to the standard rate (i.e., no valet parking).

In addition, you will need complete the attached NRC-64 voucher for reimbursement upon return from travel, no later than, Friday, April 11th. Review the itemized list for accuracy, including hotel, hotel tax and any additional authorized expenses. Then sign the NRC-64 and e-mail back to me as one document with your hotel (individual days & a zero balance), taxi/uber (tip not to exceed 15%), flight receipt, and any other receipts over \$75.
