INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

<u>ACCEPTANCE</u>: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Health Physics for Uranium Recovery (F-104) Course. This course is scheduled to be presented May 5-9, 2025, at the Wyoming Thyra Thomson State Office Building. The State Office Building is located at 444 W. Collins Dr., Casper, Wyoming 82601.

COURSE: Please note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. mountain time on Monday, May 5th and ends at 11:00 a.m. mountain time on Friday, May 9th.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, May 4th, and depart on Friday, May 9th. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Friday, you may elect to depart on Saturday, May 10th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday. Students need to make their lodging and air travel arrangements through El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to the NRC. If the need arises and you must make any changes or have questions, contact Karen Meyer at AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov.

Please complete the Travel Estimate Expense Form, attached to email. and submit to AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than, Friday, April 25th. The per diem for Casper, WY is \$110 for hotel and \$68 for meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent. Students are responsible for their own transportation (taxi/uber/subway, etc.) between the hotel and the training center. If you are authorized to drive your personal vehicle, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 70 cents per mile.

- State vehicles are **not** authorized for mileage reimbursement.
- Rental cars are **not** authorized for reimbursement.
- Airport parking is allowed for personal and State vehicles; however, we will only reimburse up to the standard rate (i.e., no valet parking).

If you live or work within 35 miles (one way) of the training facility, you will not receive per diem and lodging reimbursements.

In addition, you will need complete the attached NRC-64 voucher, attached to the email, for reimbursement upon return from travel, no later than Friday, May 16th. Review the itemized list for accuracy, including hotel, hotel tax and any additional authorized expenses. Then sign the NRC-64 and e-mail back to me as one document with your hotel (individual days & a zero balance), flight receipt, and any other receipts over \$75.
