- Oct 94 Glenn request for “path forward” on inconsistencies, gaps, and overlaps in radiation standards
- First meeting April 1995
- Meetings involve predecisional intragovernmental issues
- Co-chairs: John Greeves, NRC
Frank Marcinowski, EPA
- Members: DOE, DOD, HHS, DOL, DOT, OMB
- Observers: OSTP, States

ISCORS Objectives

- facilitate consensus on acceptable levels of radiation risk to the public and workers;
- promoting consistent risk assessment and risk management approaches;
- promoting completeness and coherence of Federal standards for radiation protection; and
- identifying interagency issues and coordinate their resolution.
