MEETINGS IN LISLE, ILLINOIS AND MANSFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS BETWEEN THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION STAFF AND STAKEHOLDERS CONCERNING IMPACTS ON COMPATIBILITY CHANGES IN GENERAL LICENSE REGULATIONS
