Dear Mr. McKinley:

We have reviewed the proposed revisions to the Kentucky regulations 902 KAR 100, received by our office on June 19, 2018. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules 10 CFR Parts 33, 34, 35 (and other teletherapy regulations), 39, 61 and 71 as identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Eric Perry on July 26, 2018.

As a result of our review, we have three comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that the Kentucky regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final Kentucky regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200, "Compatibility Categories and Health and Safety Identification for NRC Regulations and Other Program Elements."

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in NMSS Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the final changes, and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety, Security, State, and Tribal Programs, NMSS.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Kentucky regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
