Dear Mr. Gavitt:

We have reviewed the proposed changes to the New York State Department of Health regulations, 16.113, 16.114, 16.2 and 16.103, received by our office on July 26, 2010. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Parts 20, 30, 40, 61, 70 and the requirements of the three amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Robert Dansereau on September 14, 2010.

As a result of our review, we have four comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that the New York State regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final New York State regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200.

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in FSME Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the final changes, and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, FSME.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other New York regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet. Also, New York DOH omits an equivalent section to 10 CFR 40.36 which requires financial assurance and recordkeeping for decommissioning requirements for "a specific license authorizing the possession and use of more than 100mCi of source material in a readily dispersible form" and for "a specific license authorizing the possession and use of quantities of source material greater than 10mCi but less than or equal to 100mCi in a readily dispersible form".  New York DOH needs to make the above changes to 16.114 and Table 16-A to meet the Compatibility Category H&S designation assigned to 10 CFR 40.36.
