We have reviewed the South Carolina proposed legally binding license condition to implement increased controls for certain licensees that possess certain radioactive materials in quantities of concern, received by our office on October 11, 2005. This license condition was reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC requirements that were transmitted from this office on September 2, 2005. We discussed our review of the license condition with you on October 11, 2005.

We have determined that the proposed South Carolina license condition, if issued without significant change, would meet the compatibility category 'B' designation in NRC Order EA-05-090.

We appreciate receiving the final license condition issued to effected South Carolina licensees.
