Dear Ms. Cardwell:

We have reviewed the final revision to the Texas Regulations for Control of Radiation, Texas Administrative Code 289.201, 289.202, 289.251, 289.252, 289.253, 289.255, 289.257, and 289.258 received by our office on November 10, 2009. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Parts 19, 20, 30, 31, 32, 34, 36, 39, 40, 61, 70, 71 and the requirements of the 12 amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Monica Perez on January 21, 2010.

As a result of our review, we have five comments which stand from NRC letters dated June 27. 2007, January 2, 2008, and January 13, 2009 and we have seven new comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that if these regulations are revised, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200.

We request that when you revise your regulations to address our comments, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in FSME Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the location of any changes made by Texas, in response to our comments, and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, FSME.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Texas Department of Health Services regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet. This letter, including the SRS Data Sheet, is posted on the FSME website: http://nrc-stp.ornl.gov/rulemaking.html.
