We have reviewed the final revisions to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC), Chapter 246-220-010 and 221-010, "*Radiation Protection - Revision of the Skin Dose Limit*", received by our office on December 15, 2004. Our review and comments are in response to the State's

radiation control rules that incorporated the amendments identified on the States Regulation Status Data Sheet (SRS). These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC rules in 10 CFR Parts 20 and the requirements of the one amendment identified in the enclosed SRS. We discussed our review of the regulations with you on December 16, 2004.

As a result of our review, we have no comments. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that the regulations, as adopted, meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure [SA-200](#).
