Dear Mr. Werner:

We have reviewed the Wisconsin proposed Administrative Code Chapter DHS 157 'Radiation Protection,' received by our office on May 9, 2022. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and Regulation Amendment Tracking System Identification Number(s) (RATS ID) 2018-1, 2018-2, 2018-3, 2019-1, 2019-2, 2020-1, 2020-2, 2020-3, and 2021-1 as identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Mark Paulson on August 27, 2022.

As a result of our review, we have 16 comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that the Wisconsin regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final Wisconsin regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200, "Compatibility Categories and Health and Safety Identification for NRC Regulations and Other Program Elements."

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in NMSS Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the final changes and provide a copy to Division of Material Safety, Security, State, and Tribal Programs, NMSS.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Wisconsin regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
