The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff (NRC) has reviewed Wyoming's letter dated January 18, 2017, that responded to the comments in the NRC's letter dated October 17, 2016, letter (ML16201A431), and the email from Joan Olmstead to Eva La dated December 21, 2016 (ML17068A195), concerning the Civil Trespass to Collect Data law, Wyoming Enrolled Act No. 61 (Data Collection Trespass Law). The NRC staff initially raised concerns regarding this law's potential impact on Wyoming's enforcement and allegation program under a 274b. Agreement when reviewing the enabling legislation contained in Wyoming House Bill HB0027, received by NRC staff on August 13, 2015.

The responses provided by the Wyoming Attorney General's Office address our concerns. We have no further comments regarding this matter.
